



Nursery - Our 'Every Day' Curriculum-

Skills practised which will enable our children to develop and progress

We are supporting the children to:	How we do it:
Develop their listening and attention.	During group activities we practise: ● Good looking ● Good listening ● Good sitting
Understand that they are part of a group and community.	● Learn new routines together ● Listen to stories together ● Sing Nursery Rhymes ● Play simple games ● Take turns, which often involves 'waiting'
Develop their communication and language.	● Use core Makaton signs with language ● 'Talk aloud' what we are doing, so that language accompanies our actions ● Extend their language, e.g. when they say, "Apple," we reply, "A juicy red apple." ● Simplify instructions into manageable steps ● Give the children time to answer ● Use 'full' words, e.g. 'I am' instead of 'I'm'
Make secure relationships	● Learn each other's names ● Learn alongside each other ● Be kind- use kind words and kind hands
Manage their self-care.	● Put on coat by spreading it on the floor and sitting on top of it to reach for the sleeves and pull it up ● Put on shoes/ wellington boots ● Use a knife and fork ● Use the toilet and wash hands ● Pour water from a jug into a cup
Regulate feelings	● Name our own feelings and recognise that our behaviour affects others ● Resilience
