Current affect of climate change

The weather is hotter, by 3 degrees in Grimsby and the glaciers in Antarctica will melt because it is so hot, the water levels will rise, so it will cause more floods.

How does this impact Grimsby(Humberside)?

Because it can take peoples lives- they are at risk by there being more floods by 2050. Grimsby is predicted to be the most flooded part of the UK, with 100,000 home being flooded.

So the flood will not only impact homes, but it will also impact: 22 ambulance stations, 90 police stations and 51 fire stations, 509 schools, 161 nurseries, and 63 college/ university buildings - 33 hospitals - 79 railway stations and 11 bus stations.

The Yorkshire and Humber Regional Adaptation Study suggests 385,500 residential properties will be impacted, even more than the 100,000.

Peoples health and wellbeing will be impacted upon by the floods.

The East Coast Mainline, trans-Pennine rail route and the M1, A1/M, M62 and M180 motorways will be affected by the flood and trains will be impacted the transport from Grimsby to Cleethorpes Train station and the other transport
