

<u>English</u> In reading we will be using a range of strategies to build fluency and develop comprehension skills using a range of texts. Based on our Roman topic, we will write a set of instructions for our non-fiction writing and a setting describing pre and post eruption of Mount Vesuvius for our fiction writing. Our text for inspiration will be ‘Escape From Pompeii’ by Christina Balit.	<u>Art</u> We will be looking at Roman pottery and will then be learning how to create coil pots out of clay and how to apply relief and indented decorations to those pots.	<u>Computing</u> In computing this term we will create a simple multiple choice Google Form to collect data.	<u>Design Technology</u> In textiles we will be creating a decorated book sleeve which includes a fastening.
